- Prepares for all classes assigned
- Maintains accurate, complete, and up-to-date records including student marks
- Proactively develop and deliver standard-aligned content for blended delivery learning. This includes but is not limited to tracking students' learning paths and monitoring content engagement metrics as well as leveraging this actionable data and proven teaching practices to fulfill learner goals.
- Meet with Practicum host site managers to:
 - Explain roles and skills of students
 - Explain roles of Southeast College instructor
 - Additional duties as outlined by Southeast College or affiliate
- Administration duties which include: Printing/accessing, administering and correcting student exams, photocopying exams prior to writing time, monitoring and recording student attendance, collection and remittance of bubble sheets to Saskatchewan Polytechnic, tabulating and submitting marks, maintenance of all program module marks for entire student body
- Monitor student success and student concerns while monitoring their abilities to cope with the demands of their program. When necessary, referring students to the College advisor or working with the Program Coordinator to identify appropriate resources for support
